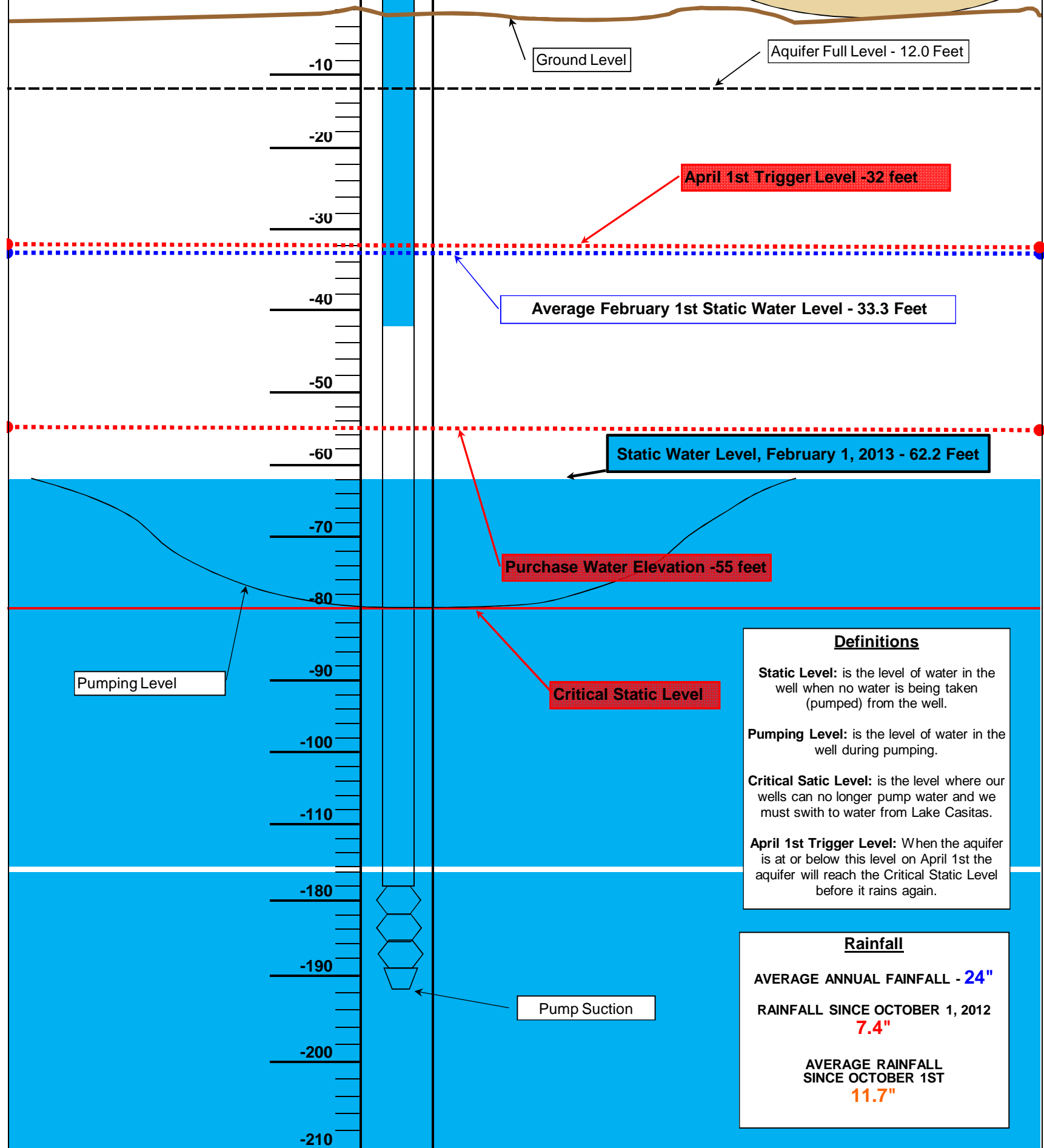
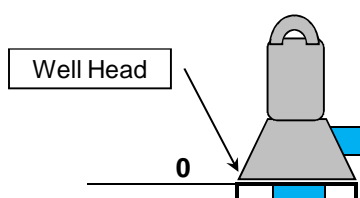
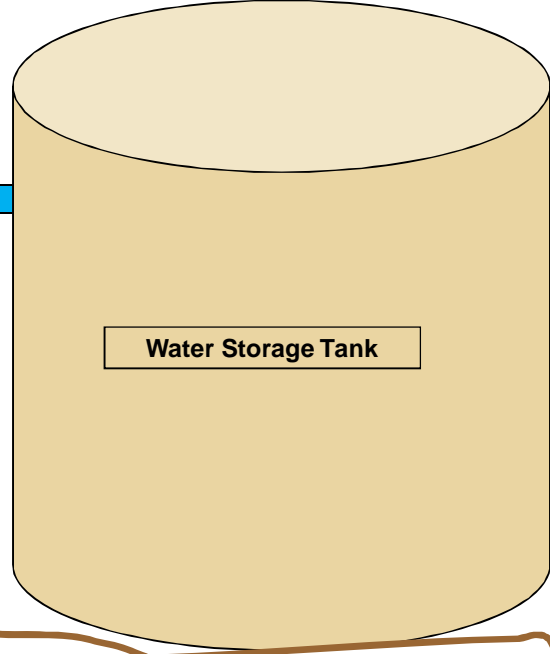


**VENTURA RIVER COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

Definitions

Static Level: is the level of water in the well when no water is being taken (pumped) from the well.

Pumping Level: is the level of water in the well during pumping.

Critical Satic Level: is the level where our wells can no longer pump water and we must swith to water from Lake Casitas.

April 1st Trigger Level: When the aquifer is at or below this level on April 1st the aquifer will reach the Critical Static Level before it rains again.
