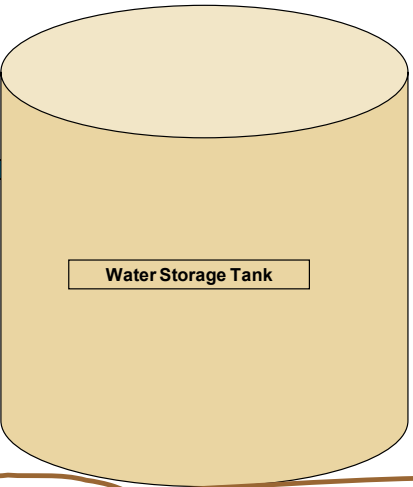
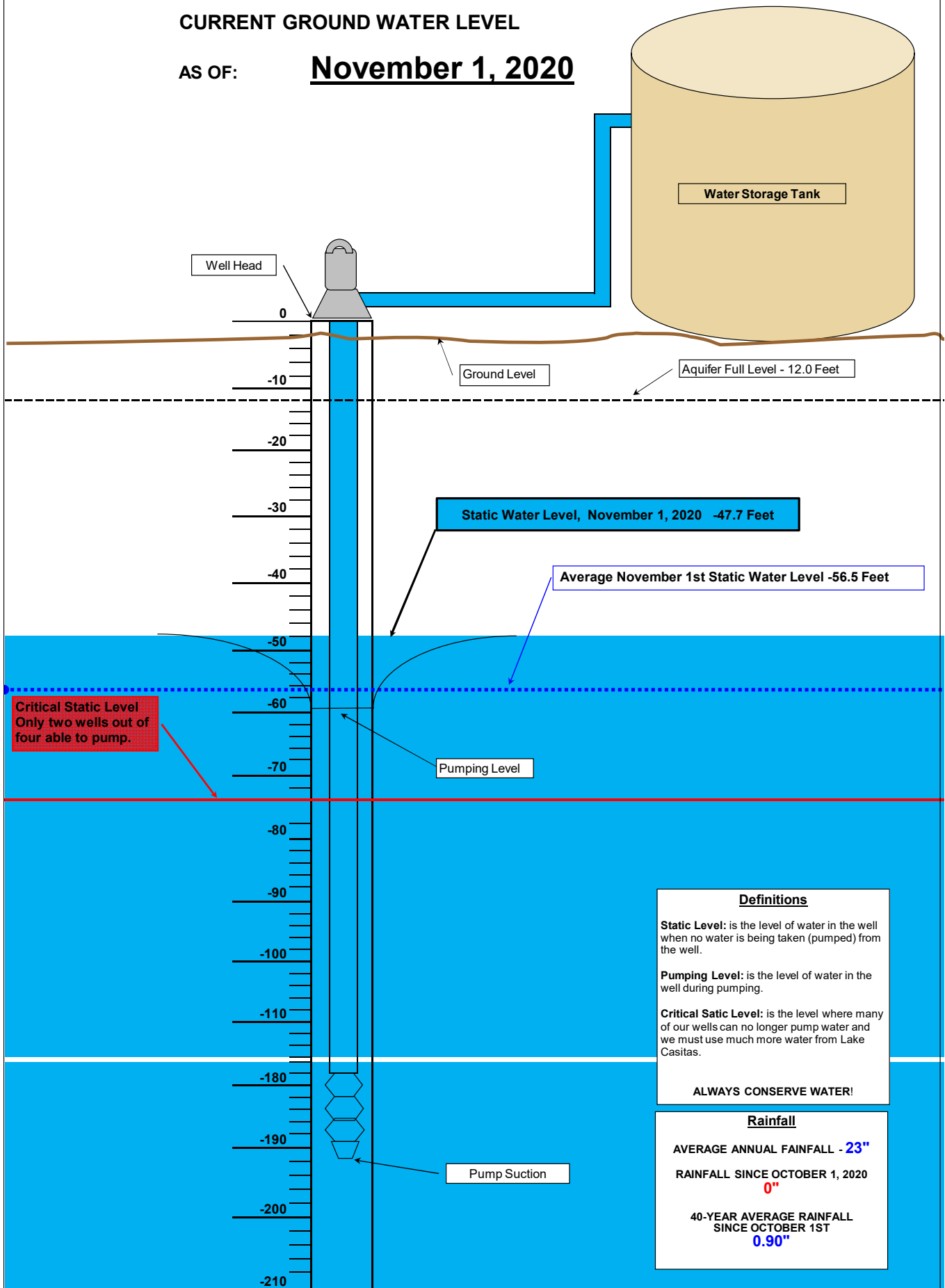

Pumping Level

Pump Suction

Definitions
Static Level: is the level of water in the well when no water is being taken (pumped) from the well.
Pumping Level: is the level of water in the well during pumping.
Critical Static Level: is the level where many of our wells can no longer pump water and we must use much more water from Lake Casitas.
