SUBJECT: WATER BUDGET PROGRAM CONCEPTS

SUMMARY

At the October 18, 2017 the Board review sever design concepts for the draft Water Budget Program. From that discussion some items were not resolved and scheduled for additional discussion at a special Board meeting November 9, 2017. The discussion items are:

- 1. The Board selected a Base Rate of about \$10 per month and Ichiko Kido with RDN indicated that she would need to report back to the Board on the precise amount of the Base Rate.
- Make a final decision on using "Variable Tiers" or "Fixed Tiers".
- 3. Prepare exhibits demonstrating outdoor water usage calculations for small and large lot homes.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

The General Manager recommends the Board take the following actions:

- 1. Base Rate use an even \$10.00 per month
- 2. Tier: Variable or Fixed Use fixed tiers; RDN will be recommending the quantity of water in each Tier at the November or December Board meeting.
- 3. Review and comment on the small and large lot Water Budget Calculation Exhibits.
- 4. Eliminate the rate differential for pumping water from Zone 1 to Zone 2.

BACKGROUND

Monthly Base Rate - RDN has determined that rounding the Base Rate to \$10.00 is appropriate rather than having it a few cents below \$10, and is comfortable with using an even \$10.00 for the Base Rate for $\frac{3}{4}$ " & 1" water

meters. During future years the Board indicated they are comfortable with the Base Rate being increased proportional with increases to usage charges.

<u>Fixed or Variable tiers</u> - RDN is comfortable with using either Fixed or Variable Tiers. The consensus of the Board at the October 18th meeting was to use Fixed Tiers but wanted to wait until RDN could give the options for additional consideration.

<u>Water Budget Calculation Exhibits</u> - RDN will provide Water Budget Calculation Exhibits at the November 9th Board meeting.

Rate Differential For Pumping - RDN recommends eliminating the rate differential for pumping water from Zone 1 to Zone 2. Utility rate setting normally does not include small differences affecting rates. For example the neighborhoods receiving Casitas water directly do not require wells, tanks or pumps and the District does not attempt to separate these areas out into separate rate categories and account for their neighborhood specific costs. In the same way RDN recommends that the rates not be divided into pumped and not pumped areas but consider all water the same and have consistent water rates across the District. If the Board desires, a separate pump charge can be applied on the water bill for those who reside in Zone 2.

FISCAL SUMMARY

The variables selected for formulation of the Water Budget Program should not affect District finances.
