





- Defines insurance requirements
- Indemnification clauses both parties





Additional \$10 M, zero-interest loan may be available for the Casitas Mutual Consolidation




Flexibility to add/remove projects from the initial \$10 M


CalWARN promotes statewide emergency preparedness

Responding members not held liable for failing to provide assistance

District's liability insurance covers employees & District when providing assistance



Immediate access to a large labor pool, materials and equipment for emergency recovery

Receive a list of emergency contacts

Indemnification if providing aid


Reimbursement of costs for sharing resources


VENTURA RIVER UPPER BASIN & LAKE CASITAS LEVELS September 18, 2023

















Item 10: Filling of General Manager Position
